Oral Presentation

- The provisional session time slot is available at <https://ifs2024.aseanfen.org/schedule/>
- The detailed schedule will be announced at a later date and distributed as a handout at the venue.
- The duration of each presentation is 15 minutes for the presentation and 5 minutes for the Q and A.
- The slide size can be either 16:9 or 4:3.
- The schedule for the start time of each presentation will not be changed, even if any cancellations occur before your presentation.
- There will be no breaks during the sessions. The coffee corner will always be open. Please enjoy taking a break as appropriate.
- Please upload your presentation file (.pptx or .pdf) by **17 November** from the link below. You can send only one file for a presentation. The file will be transmitted to the PC in the session room.
- The file name should be the **presentation number** starting from OO, OA, PO, or PA. The presentation number and the presentation starting time will be announced soon at <https://ifs2024.aseanfen.org/presentation/>

- Please bring your presentation file on a USB memory stick to the venue in case it is lost or damaged.

Poster Presentation

- Posters should be prepared and printed with final dimensions under ISO A-0 size (W841mm×H1189mm). Printing services will not be available at the venue. Tacks will be provided.
- Posters can be displayed from 09:00 on November 20th. Please display the poster by 12:00 on the 20th at the latest.
- All presenters are requested to be at your poster to answer questions during the core time. For presenters with odd-numbered presentation numbers, the core time is the first half of the session (21 November, 12:00-13:00), while those with even-numbered presentation numbers will present in the second half (21 November, 13:00-14:00).
- Please remove your poster by 15:00 on 21 November. The steering committee will dispose of any posters left after this time.

Presentation Certificate

- After the Steering Committee confirms that the presentation has been made, a certificate of presentation will be issued for all presentations and handed to the presenter on the spot.
- It will not be handed to the presenter outside the presentation venue.

Awards

- If you declared as an early career researcher at registration, your presentation is a candidate for awards.

The winners will be announced at the Closing Banquet and will get a certificate, trophy and additional prize.

Publishing Support for IFS2024 Presenters

Authors who presented their work at IFS2024 can submit a full paper to *Fisheries Science* with potential publishing support from IFS2024.

Procedure

1. Make a manuscript with the acknowledgement, mentioning that 'The contents of the article was presented in the 12th International Fisheries Symposium (IFS2024) held in Hakodate, Japan on 19-22 November 2024, co-hosted by Hokkaido University and ASEAN Fisheries Education Network'.
2. Submit your manuscript to *Fisheries Science (FS)* and collect the PDF file created by the Editorial Manager of FS after the submission. The submitted manuscripts will be peer-reviewed independently by the Editorial Board of *FS*.
3. Submit the PDF to the IFS2024 Steering Committee by the deadline. The IFS2024 Steering Committee reviews manuscripts and selects those for which IFS2024 will cover the page charge if *FS* accepts them. The selection results will be announced by the end of January. The number of manuscripts for the page charge support may be decided on IFS2024, considering the budget limitations.
4. If the selected manuscripts are accepted, IFS2024 will pay the page charge to Fisheries Science. If *FS* accepts the manuscript but IFS2024 does not select it, the page charge invoice will go to the author(s). If the author does not pay the page charge, the manuscript will not be published.

At present, the page charge for *FS* is 7600 JPY/page. *FS*'s publication format is a subscription with a non-downloadable open-access URL. Those who want full open access can choose the open access option for the APC 3690USD. IFS2024 does not cover the APC.
